The College of Health and Human Performance at the University of Florida invites applications and nominations for the position of Professor and Chair, Department of Applied Physiology and Kinesiology. The Department, which enrolls about 650 students (570 undergraduates, 80 graduates) consists of 17 full-time faculty. The Department is housed in a recently renovated building which includes state-of-the-art research facilities and lecture halls. With an outstanding faculty and staff, the Department is poised to become one of the premier Applied Physiology and Kinesiology Departments in the United States.

The Chair serves as chief administrative officer of the Department and reports to the Dean of the College of Health and Human Performance. The Chair will:

- Foster scholarship and external support activity of a diverse and highly dedicated faculty;
- Serve as a strong advocate for the department's mission within the college and university;
- Develop collaborative relationships within the university as well as with the national and international community;
- Implement sound fiscal management and planning;
- Supervise and support strong mentorship to junior faculty and students;
- Develop and maintain appropriate curricula for the department's academic programs.

Candidates must possess an earned doctorate, a distinguished record of scholarship and external funding commensurate with appointment at rank of tenured Professor. Applicants should have outstanding leadership skills, managerial and communication skills; and a commitment to integrity, academic excellence, professional service, and cultural diversity. The Chair must have the ability and willingness to foster positive relations with alumni, donors, and friends of the Department and College.

This is a 12-month position with an expected begin date of July 1, 2007. Salary is negotiable. The application deadline is February 5, 2007. Applications must include both a hard copy and electronic copy of the following: (1) a letter of application summarizing the applicant's qualifications, (2) a complete curriculum vitae, and (3) names, addresses, e-mail addresses, and telephone numbers of at least five references.
