DEPARTMENT CHAIR POSITION

The University of Florida seeks applicants for the position of **Professor and Chair**, Department of Health Education & Behavior, in the College of Health and Human Performance. The department offers Ph.D., M.S., and B.S. degrees. The Chair will provide leadership for a department of 15 faculty members and some 300 students in achieving its vision of excellence in research and graduate education.

Qualifications:

Potential candidates must possess a vision of research and graduate education compatible with the goals of the College of Health and Human Performance and the University of Florida; a record of scholarly activity and external funding commensurate with appointment to the rank of full Professor with tenure; appropriate professional training, including a doctoral degree; evidence of administrative ability, positive communication skills, and responsible financial management; ability and willingness to mentor junior faculty members and students; support for the process of shared governance; and commitment to the principles of equal opportunity, affirmative action, and cultural diversity.

Application:

Interested individuals may apply for the position through the University of Florida's centralized employment website at <https://jobs.ufl.edu>. Please use the "Short Application" form (job reference number 0700783) to submit a letter of application that describes the applicant's vision for promoting research and graduate education in the Department of Health Education & Behavior, and a detailed curriculum vita that includes the applicant's education, experience, scholarly activities, and related information. Application deadline is JANUARY 19th, 2007. Following the initial screening process, the search committee may request applicants who remain in consideration for the position to provide letters of recommendation to the committee. This is a 12-month position and the official start date of employment is expected to be July 1, 2007. Salary is negotiable.

Women and minorities are encouraged to apply. The Government of Florida (sunshine laws) requires that all documents relating to the search process, including letters of application/nomination and reference, be available for public inspection.
